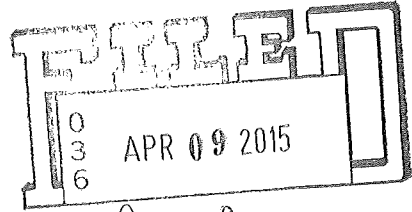

E.F.A.C.'s REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION OF JANUARY 21, 2014 ORDER

COMES NOW, the Epworth Forest Administration Committee (E.F.A.C.), and for its request for Clarification of the Court's January 21, 2014 Order, hereby states as follows:

1. The E.F.A.C. is in the process of billing for Pier Fees for on-shore and off-shore, residents, and the Community Pier. It is also in the process of reviewing pier placement and assignments. In this process, the E.F.A.C. wants to implement the Court's Orders and its Pier Administration Policy as intended by the Court.

2. The E.F.A.C. is attempting to reconcile the January 21, 2014 Order, under the **Order** section, paragraph 7. c) and how it relates to Exhibit C, paragraph 9., "Pier Transfers" of the same Order.


3. The E.F.A.C. would like clarification from the Court as to whether the Court's January 21, 2014 Order intended:

- a) All requests for pier sites and/or slips be assigned in the order they are received, which would include a resident of Epworth Forest who purchases a property from a prior property owner that had assigned pier access;
- b) Paragraph 7. c) under the **Order** section of the Court's January 21, 2014 Order does not relate to pier transfers as listed in Exhibit C, paragraph 9., "Pier Transfers" of the same Order; or
- c) Some other interpretation.

WHEREFORE, the E.F.A.C., by unanimous agreement and request, would appreciate the Court's guidance in this matter, and for all other just and proper relief in the premises.
