**Application/Fee Guidelines**

- 1 **Applications will be accepted from January 2 to February 1, 2014. After February 1 pier placements will be awarded based on order of applications received and payment of fees.**
- 2 The placement of any pier or boat at any location under the jurisdiction of the Town shall be registered with the Town, prior to placement, subject to the following:
  - a. The person shall be a resident of the Town;
  - b. The person shall show proof of insurance and maintain personal liability insurance on the placement in an amount not less than \$500,000; or to match TORT limit. Each registered pier owner shall maintain personal liability insurance in an amount determined by the Town for the annual placement of each pier. The pier owner shall indemnify the Town for any loss resulting from the use of the pier, attachments or watercraft.
  - c. The person shall pay an annual registration fee of \$100 upon approval; and
  - d. Additional pier owner(s) may be approved by the Town upon registration and payment to attach to a previously registered pier.
- 3 No person shall be allowed to place or launch any boat, trailer, or personal watercraft from the street or alleys owned by the Town without prior authorization by the Town.
- 4 No registered owners or other users of piers or boats located in the Town jurisdiction shall park any vehicles, trailers or boats on the street or alley giving rise to the Town's authority to control its riparian rights. No one is allowed to store property or equipment at or on the pier.
- 5 The Town shall have the authority to control the use and maintenance of piers after placement. The Town shall give written notice of any violation to the owner(s). In the event an owner fails to satisfy the requirement contained therein, the Town shall have the right to order the owner to remove all property from the location; if the owner fails to remove such property, the Town shall have the authority to remove all such property and seek the costs for such action from the owner.
- 6 Any resident of the Town can apply.
- 7 Only one pier registration per resident will be allowed.

**Pier Guidelines**

- 1 The registered piers in Syracuse lake shall conform to the following conditions:
  - a. The total length of each registered family shall not be less than three (3) or more than five (5) sections, each 12 foot in length;
  - b. Each pier section shall be four (4) foot in width; no more than two sections wide.
  - c. Each registered pier shall be placed perpendicular to the property line;
  - d. Each pier section shall conform to the prior pier section whether placed by an original or subsequent pier owner.
  - e. Each pier section shall be maintained in good maintenance and repair.
  - f. Each pier and any attachments or watercraft shall not be installed prior to April 1 and be removed prior to November 1 of each year.
- 2 The registered piers placed in the channels of Syracuse or Wawasee Lakes shall be subject to the conditions set in 1 above with the following exceptions:
  - a. The length of a registered pier shall not be less than two (2) sections; and
  - b. Each pier section shall be three (3) foot in width.
  - c. Piers shall not be subject to 1f. above (removal of piers).
- 3 On Alley easements parking of boats are limited to one side of the pier only.
- g. The placement shall be subject to the Indiana Code, Regulations and rules of the DNR.
- h. No boat lifts other than a single personal watercraft lift.
